

Report of Non-Parochial Clergy in the Diocese of Southeast Florida

Title I Canon 6 of the Episcopal Church requires that: "Every Bishop, Presbyter, or deacon whose report is not included in a parochial report shall also report on the exercise of such office, and if there has been none, the causes or reasons which have prevented the same."

Title III Canon 15 states that the clergy: "Shall forward a copy of the report required by Canon 1.6.1 to the Ecclesiastical Authority to whose jurisdiction the Deacon or Priest has removed."
